Phase Matrix defeated for the first time in 19 games.

Phase Matrix was defeated by the K-Wings by a final score of 8-6. PM struck first on goals by Steve Wilhide and Kevin Nichols. Then the K-Wings made it 2-1. Sean O'Connell put PM up 3-1; however the K-Wings would score with just 33 seconds remaining in the 1st period for a 3-2 score. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> the K-Wings would strike 3 times before Jim Olsen scored for PM and the second period ended 5-4 in favor of the K-Wings. In the 3<sup>rd</sup> period PM goals by Gil Harrison, pinching in and deflecting a Jim Olsen shot, and Craig Takeuchi blasting one in from just inside the blue line would tie the score at 6. But with 2:53 remaining in the game, the K-Wings would take advantage of a power play and net the go ahead goal. Even with that, PM was not out of the game and had several scoring chances until the K-Wings iced this one with an empty net goal with 12 seconds remaining.
